- **March 6th and 7th – STRINGFEVER** - Meet Giles, Ralph, Graham & Neal Broadbent, aka **Stringfever**. With their electric instruments and unique sound, the world's first genetically modified string quartet combine exceptional musical skill with a real talent for involving and engaging audiences to provide you with a night you'll never forget!
- **March 14th and 15th – CAHAL DUNNE** – Back by popular demand, "Ireland's Piano Man - The Man of Many Jackets", possesses that certain magical quality known in show business as "it." "It" transcends talent. "It" comes from deep within a great entertainer and washes over an audience, captivating them. Join us for a St. Patrick's celebration like no other!
- **March 27th and 28th – ROCKET MAN** – Simply put - this is Elton! Scotsman Rus Anderson recreates the magic & live persona of a young Elton like no other.
