- January 8th and 9th – *The Duttons*** – Straight from their own theater in Branson, Missouri where they perform over 300 shows a year, the Duttons bring their all-in-the-family show to our stage! Finalists on “America’s Got Talent”, the Duttons will keep you entertained with music, dance and comedy. A great way to start our season!
- January 22nd and 23rd – *Zachary James*** – Zachary James grew up in Spring Hill, graduating from Springstead High School, and is now a star on Broadway! His list of achievements is too long to list here, but includes playing Lurch on Broadway in “The Addams Family”, Amenhotep III in “Akhnaten” at the Metropolitan Opera, and Thomas Hassinger in “South Pacific” at Lincoln Center. His rich, deep bass/baritone singing voice, matching his 6’6” frame, provides an incredible experience as he performs hit songs from Broadway’s greatest musicals. Welcome home, Zach!
- February 12th and 13th – *Tribute to Whitney Houston*** – Jade Milian Warshaw takes our audience on a journey through the music of the incomparable Whitney Houston as she captures the look and sound that made her a legend. Fans of Whitney will be amazed as Jade covers the hits that resonate with audiences to this day. A wonderful tribute to the late, great Whitney Houston!
- February 26th and 27th – *Dawson Hollow*** – If you’ve been coming to CPAG shows for a while, you may remember a family group called Link Union. When their parents retired from touring, the kids decided to continue as *Dawson Hollow*, reborn as an indie-folk band, with a blend of traditional folk, bluegrass and country, updated with a fresh, contemporary vibe. This family of musicians will keep you entertained throughout the show with their talent and personalities. A must-see show!
- March 12th and 13th – *The British Invasion Years*** – Three shows in one! First, the classic songs by iconic 60s British groups such as The Who, the Rolling Stones, the Kinks and the Zombies. Second, the American “response” from groups such as The Monkees, Beach Boys, Doors and Steppenwolf. Then the finale, the four lads that started it all –The Beatles! Come celebrate the 60s with *The British Invasion Years!*
- March 26th and 27th – *Tribute to Neil Diamond*** – Another award-winning Branson performer, Keith Allynn brings his spot-on tribute to Neil Diamond to our stage. Allynn’s mesmerizing style, intimacy with the audience, and portrayal of Neil Diamond’s hits make this tribute the only way to “Experience the Feel of Neil”.
- April 16th and 17th – *South of the Border – The Ultimate Tijuana Brass Tribute*** – *Basil Rodriguez began playing trumpet in 1964 in elementary school, at a time when Herb Alpert was a rising star with his Tijuana Brass. After a successful career as a professional trumpet player, Basil had a 38-year run as Assistant Music Director and staff musician at Busch Gardens – Tampa. He has now come full circle and brings his meticulously recreated sounds of the Tijuana Brass, Brasil 66 and others to our venue.*
